MG Pre-War and TYme Event 2021 Event and Registration Information

The Event

MG Car Club Canberra Inc. (MGCC Canberra) extends a warm invitation to the owners, partners of owners, and the minders of MG Pre-War, T Type, and Y Type cars to a socially oriented event to be held in Canberra from Friday 1 October to Monday 4 October 2021.

In 2021 the event brings together the biennial Pre-War MG Register national rally and the MG TYme celebration of the T and Y Type MG cars.

Eligibility for Registration

The event is for the owners, partners of owners, and minders of MG Pre-War, T Type, and Y Type cars to enjoy social interaction and motoring activities focussed on these cars. MGCC Canberra recognises that not all cars will be road registered, but the event is primarily designed for those who intend to bring eligible road-registered cars to Canberra for the event.

There will be ‘public parts’ of the event program for all MG enthusiasts to enjoy such as the display day, and the cars will travel on public roads. MGCC Canberra has however restricted event registration to enthusiasts or other interested persons who own, or who are the custodian of an MG Pre-War, T Type, or Y Type car.

The event is socially oriented and designed to allow free time for drivers and co-drivers to explore Canberra’s fabulous attractions and institutions. The event is timed to coincide with Canberra’s internationally acclaimed floral festival *Floriade*, although at the time of writing we are unsure of the Floriade 2021 arrangements.

Accommodation

The Alpha Motel, 46 Rowland Rees Crescent, Greenway, ACT 2900 <https://alphahotelcanberra.com.au/> has been booked as 'Event Central'. The Motel has 100 rooms pre-booked for the event; and will offer a special B&B rate for guests. This motel:

- Is convenient to a retail town-centre and a trunk route for public transport
- Has ample free parking that is reasonably secure. Parking is available for car-trailers, and parked cars can be seen from many of the rooms
- Is adjacent or convenient to the venues for registration and most event activities.

Registrants are responsible for arranging their own accommodation. When booking at the Alpha Motel please quote *MG Car Club Canberra*. Phone bookings to the motel on 02 6293 3666 are recommended.

Registrants may of course choose anywhere else for their accommodation. If the reserved accommodation at the Alpha Motel fills; one suitable alternate motel to 'Event Central' is the Ibis Styles Motel at Narrabundah. <https://www.ibisstylescanberra.com.au/>

MG Car Club Canberra Workshop and Club Car Trailer

MGCC Canberra has a workshop with a hoist, wheel balancer, and many specialist tools. Registrants will be welcome to use this facility or borrow the Club car trailer if they breakdown during the event. Access details will be provided prior to 1 October.

Registration and Payments

Registrations will close on Wednesday 22 September 2021.

Registration fees have been set at: \$110 for the 'first registrant', and \$100 for 'each additional registrant' attending. Each first registrant will receive an event Souvenir Program and an event memento. What is included and not included in the registration fee for all registrants is outlined below:

For T Type and Y Type registrants, a new function will be hosted by MGCC Canberra. Attendance at these (sub) register functions is optional and at your own expense.

Refund Policy

The Event is being planned and run by MGCC Canberra 'at cost' to registrants. If the event is cancelled, or if a registrant requests withdrawal prior to commencement of the event, a full refund will be provided less any unavoidable costs that have been incurred by the Club.

Nametags and Chairs

Registrants are requested to bring their own Club nametags, and if possible, also pack a fold-up chair for the Sunday picnic run.

Car-trailers

We expect many registrants will choose to bring a car-trailer. Plans will be made to accommodate the trailers in the motel and adjoining Vikings Club car parks. It will assist the event organisers if you tick the box on the registration form to indicate that you intend to bring a car trailer that will require parking at a motel.

A Carbon-Neutral Event

MGCC Canberra has an environmental policy that includes a commitment to ‘...endeavour to off-set the carbon emissions that result from the use of members cars that are used in association with Club activities...’ For normal Club activities we do this by asking members to add an annually calculated contribution with their membership subscription.

An estimate has been made of the tonnes of CO2 attributable to participants in this particular event. The required carbon off-set has been calculated at an average of \$2 per Pre-War, T, and Y Type car. Registrants will be invited to add this amount to their event registration fee.

The payment of a contribution to carbon off-set is emphasised as voluntary. All monies collected will be used by the Club to engage with a partner organisation to off-set the event CO2 emissions. This may be in the form of practical assistance (eg tree-planting or assisting with reforestation activities), or by a donation, or similar.

A Swap Table and Market Stall at the Display on the Saturday

An ‘MG swap table/market stall’ will be setup at the display on the Saturday. Event participants are invited to bring small and clean MG parts, regalia, books, and memorabilia to the table. MGCC Canberra will appoint a shopkeeper to assist on the day.

And a Final Word about COVID-19

MGCC Canberra is optimistic that the event will be able to be conducted after the worst of COVID-19 restrictions have been lifted. Registrants are assured that all ACT Government and public health protocols and requirements will be strictly met, monitored, and communicated to event participants.
